

How to apply for specifications?

Sorters and Preprocessors


Step 1: access the Experiments Area





- Go to the Refashion
 Recycle platform:
 https://recycle.refashion.
 fr/en/access-the platform/
- In the « My Company » section, go to the **Experiments Area**
- Read the terms and conditions for participation on <u>Recycle</u> <u>website</u>

Step 2: view ongoing campaigns






- **1.** The status indicates the campaigns in progress.
- 2. Download and consult the specs* proposed by Recyclers. Warning: specifications are confidential and must not be shared.
- 3. Click on « **See** » to access the specs list and participate in one or more experiments. You can respond to multiple specs (from the same recycler or not).
- Reminder: you have until the end date of a campaign to take part.


Step 3: respond to specifications 1/4





- 1. Read the different specs in the downloaded PDF files.
- 2. If the « Colors » and/or « Trim removal/Dismantling » and/or « Format operation » sections are empty, this means that the specs do not require these operations: trim removal/ dismantling and/or color sorting (multicolour desired) and/or format operation (full CHF desired). You will not need to complete these steps in the response form.
- 3. Click on « See » on the home page, then « Submit an **answer** » on the specifications to which you wish to respond.


Step 3: respond to specifications 2/4






- Complete your response as you go along.
 Save your progress by clicking on « Save a draft ». Please note: if you click on « Cancel », you will lose your progress.
- To continue to the next section, please ensure that you have completed all mandatory fields.
 You can return to the previous section to modify it.
- If a sorting (material/color) or processing (trim removal/format) step does not appear in your response form, this means that the specs do not require these operations.
- Use the scroll bar on the right to view and fill in all fields.

Step 3: respond to specifications 3/4 - save a methodology








- To respond to a specifications, you need to fill in your methodology for sorting/processing/quality control. Click on « Create a new methodology » then « Save ».
- Once created, you can reuse it in a response to another specifications if the methodology used is the same. Select it from the drop-down list.


Step 3: respond to specifications 4/4





- If a sorting (material/color) or processing (trim removal/format) step does not appear in the costs to be completed, this means that the specs do not require these operations.
- If necessary, you can change the cost unit (€/t).
- control Click on « Validate » to submit your finalised response to Refashion. They will no longer be editable while Refashion reviews the specifications. Modifications can then be made based on Refashion feedback.

Step 4: follow up your application



The status of your specs:



- 1. **Draft:** your specs are **editable**, <u>you</u> must validate them before sending them to Refashion.
- Filed: your specs remain available for consultation but can no longer be modified. They are currently being reviewed by Refashion.
- **3. In process:** Refashion analyses your response and will get back to you.
- Request for further information: Refashion is waiting for further details*, to modify your specs click on « See details » and validate the specs again.
- Validated: your final specifications have been validated by Refashion and will be submitted to sorters.
 / Refused: Refashion reserves the right to select specs according to several criteria (see Rules).
